<b>When is this form required?</b>	<p>This form is required to be completed by an official Government end user when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The goods are subject to import control under Regulation 4H and listed in Schedule 13 (Part 2) of the <i>Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956</i>; and</li><li>• Permission to import is being applied for under the OFFICIAL PURPOSES TEST or the SPECIFIED PURPOSES TEST; and</li><li>• The end user is the government of the Commonwealth, or the Government of a State or Territory or an overseas country;</li></ul>
<b>Who must complete this form?</b>	<p>This form <b>must</b> be completed by the relevant Government official when goods are being imported for the government of the Commonwealth, or the Government of a State or Territory or an overseas country under the official or specified purposes test.</p> <p>This form <b>cannot</b> be completed by the importer.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Form details will be verified by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection to ensure the form was completed by the relevant Government official and the goods subject to import approval and their quantity matches the goods and quantity required by the official Government user. <b>Any inconsistencies identified on verification may be subject to investigation and subsequent legal action. Making a false or misleading statement to a Department of Immigration and Border Protection officer is an offence under Section 234(1)(d) of the Customs Act 1901 and carries a maximum penalty of \$11,000.</b></p>
<b>Timeframes</b>	<p>Applications must be lodged prior to importation and goods cannot be imported until permission to import has been approved.</p> <p>Applications take approximately four weeks for processing once all relevant information is received.</p> <p>If your application does not include all the required documentation, processing time may be longer.</p>
