# APPLICATION FOR TARIFF CONCESSION ORDER (TCO)

IMPORTANT: Please read the information below carefully before completing this form.

## Are you aware that substitutable goods are produced in Australia in the ordinary course of business?

(a) If you are aware, based on information and your inquiries that substitutable goods are being produced in Australia in the ordinary course of business then you should not lodge an application for a TCO.

# Do you need to apply for new TCO?

(b) Before lodging this application for a TCO, the applicant should determine whether a suitable TCO already exists. Information on existing TCOs is contained in the Schedule of Concessional Instruments (SCI), which is available on the Internet at www.customs.gov.au.

- (c) Section 269FA of the *Customs Act 1901* states "It is the responsibility of an applicant for a TCO to establish, to the satisfaction of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), that, on the basis of:
  - (i) all information that the applicant has, or can reasonably be expected to have; and
  - (ii) all inquiries that the applicant has made, or can reasonably be expected to make; there are reasonable grounds for asserting that the application meets the core criteria".

The application is taken to meet the core criteria if, on the day of lodgement of the application, **no substitutable goods** were produced in Australia in the ordinary course of business.

## Completing the application

- (d) Section 269F of the Customs Act 1901 requires that a TCO application be in writing, be in an "approved form", contain such information as the form requires, and be signed in the manner indicated in the form.
  This is the approved form for the purposes of that section.
- (e) Section 269F(3) states that a TCO application must contain:
  - (a) a full description of the goods to which the application relates; and
  - (b) a statement of the tariff classification that, in the opinion of the applicant, applies to the goods; and
  - (c) if the applicant is not proposing to make use of the TCO to import the goods to which the application relates into Australia on the applicant's own behalf the identity of the importer for whom the applicant is acting; and
  - (d) particulars of all inquiries made by the applicant (including inquiries made of prescribed organisations) to assist in establishing that there were reasonable grounds for believing that on the day on which the application was lodged, there were no producers in Australia of substitutable goods.

#### Question 1 to 8 must be answered

- (f) Failure to supply the information required by this form will result in rejection of the application (and in the loss of operative date.)
- (g) Customs and Border Protection may require an applicant to substantiate, with documentary evidence, any information provided in the application form. Customs and Border Protection may also undertake its own inquiries as allowed under section 269M.
- (h) Receipt of your application will be acknowledged. Any resultant TCO will operate from the date of receipt.
- (i) Where an application is accepted as being a valid application, the identity of the applicant and of the importer for whom the applicant is acting will be published in the *Commonwealth of Australia Tariff Concessions Gazette* (the Gazette).

  - (a) they have been produced in Australia in the 2 years before the application was lodged; or
  - (b) they have been produced, and are held in stock, in Australia; or
  - (c) they are produced in Australia on an intermittent basis and have been so produced in the 5 years before the application was lodged;

and a producer in Australia is prepared to accept an order to supply them.

- (2) For the purposes of this Part, goods that:
  - (a) are substitutable goods in relation to goods the subject of a TCO application; and
  - (b) are made to order capital equipment;


#### PASSION FOR PAPER

#### ENVIRONMENT

#### SUSTAINING OUR FUTURE

Our approach to the environment is allencompassing. To have a true environmental focus we must work on all of these stages in unison, and constantly strive for improvements and innovations in order to sustain our future.

#### SUSTAINABLE RAW MATERIALS

Detpak assesses everything that goes into manufacturing our products for its environmental impact. Detpak only uses paper and board from large, reputable raw material suppliers meaning no old growth forests are used. Detpak regularly audits its suppliers for evidence of sustainability. We keep the use of inks and adhesives to a minimum and we also prioritise the use of water-based and soy inks. These are more environmentally friendly than solvent based inks as they use less non-renewable resources.

# RESPONSIBLE MANUFACTURING PRACTICES

We continually assess our manufacturing practices to make our processing as sustainable as possible. We minimise our inputs where possible which includes reducing our use of power and our use of solvent based inks and adhesives. We also maximise the re-use of production setup materials. Detpak takes into account its own level of packaging and we minimise the amount of outer packaging on all of our products to customers. Our waste is always disposed of in line with Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved practices,

#### PACKAGING CHOICES

Many of the options in the Detpak range are environmentally friendly because they are based on paper or board - a renewable resource. We also offer the I am eco™ range of products, which uses bio-film rather than traditional plastic lining and is 100% biodegradable. The range of raw material options available to us is continually advancing, and we are actively investigating and trialling alternate renewable materials to give our customers more choice. We assess these products with a view to being both highly functional and environmentally sustainable. Our team can guide you through product comparisons to meet your specific environmental and packaging objectives.

#### END OF LIFE DISPOSAL Detpak works with waste

management and resource recovery stakeholders to develop increasingly sustainable options for product disposal, including diverting products into new recycling streams. Detpak was also one of the first signatories to the Australian Packaging Covenant, an initiative that encourages businesses to reduce the environmental impacts of consumer packaging. Detpak is proactive in meeting its obligations under the covenant and we promote resource efficient packaging design; the recovery and recycling of used packaging, and reducing the incidence and impact of litter. The Detpak team can advise you on the best packaging options to suit your disposal or recycling needs.

#### STEP 1:

MATCHING THE PRODUCT WITH THE PACKAGING

Although it might look simple on the surface, there are actually a lot of different factors to think about when you're packaging a product. The checklist below will help you make sure you consider every option.

#### Does the packaging support the shelf-life of my product?

Airtight packaging is often needed if products are being stored rather than consumed instantly

#### Can the packaging cope with the moisture and grease level of my product?

Packaging with a lining may be needed for wet or oily products.

#### Will my customers be able to easily open and/or transport the packaging if necessary?

Ease of opening and the ability to consume 'on-the-go' are important considerations for take-away packaging.

#### Does the product fit well within the packaging?

Oversized packaging can increase costs, and food moving within containers can affect product integrity. Ask for packaging samples to test sizing for your specific products.

#### Is the packaging safe for food?

All of Detpak's products are made from certified food grade materials and manufactured in plants accredited for food safety and quality consistency (HACCP; BRC, AIB, ISO9001).

#### Can the packaging support our service goals?

Pre-formed packaging can decrease handling time, while windows allow for prepackaging of items to increase sales during rush hours.

#### STEP 2:

SETTING YOUR ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL GOALS

Use our Environmental Checkpoint system (page 17) to help you to evaluate each packaging item against four key criteria and assess: is the item sustainable, compostable, recyclable or re-usable?

#### STEP 3:

MAXIMISING EXPOSURE FOR YOUR BUSINESS

Product packaging can help you build your brand and increase business. It is important to choose packaging with a 'look and feel' to match your brand. This may involve simply choosing a stock colour (generic) that fits your image or custom printing your packaging.

#### STOCK PACKAGING

Many of our products are available in plain colours or subtle stock prints that can be easily worked into the décor of your store. Small touches can make these products your own, like stamps, stickers, ribbons or ties. Stock or generic products are available by the carton, usually with 200–1000 pieces per carton. This means you aren't tied up with loads of stock, taking up room and money.

#### **CUSTOM PRINTING**

All of Detpak's products can be custom printed with your design to help you stand out from the crowd. Custom printing is often thought of as an expensive option, but there are many ways to maximise your exposure without breaking the bank.

We often recommend that businesses on a budget start with custom printing just one packaging item from our range. An ideal place to start is a carry bag, as it will generally house all of your other items. They are economical, use minimal space in-store, have a low minimum run (starting at 3000 pieces) and can be used to great effect with a 1-colour print. Carry bags will advertise your business as customers carry them from the store, and are also much more likely to be re-used, extending their lifespan.

Wraps are also a versatile option to add branding to your range. They can be used to line food trays, lunch boxes, pails or serving platters as well as wrapping food. Wraps are very economical, use little storage space and can be easily used in-store and for takeaway items.
