On 21 April 2017, the Department received an FOI request seeking access to:

Scope

- 1. For the Syrians in the additional 12,000:
 - a. For those that had Australia sponsors, the number that had direct relatives such as a brother/sister/parent/child and how many were sponsored by an approved proposer
- 2. For the Syrians in the 2015-16 Humanitarian Programme
 - a. For those that had Australia sponsors, the number that had direct relatives such as a brother/sister/parent/child and how many were sponsored by an approved proposer

The Department is able to produce from its computer systems, a report of the data sought:

- 1. For the Syrians in the additional 12,000:
 - a. For those that had Australia sponsors, the number that had direct relatives such as a brother/sister/parent/child and how many were sponsored by an approved proposer

Of the 5620 Syrians granted a visa as part of the additional 12000 places for Syrians and Iraqis displaced by conflict in their home countries:

- 2638 were proposed by an immediate¹ or close family member².
- 51 were proposed by an Approved Proposing Organisation through the CPP (Community Proposal Pilot)
- 2. For the Syrians in the 2015-16 Humanitarian Programme
 - a. For those that had Australia sponsors, the number that had direct relatives such as a brother/sister/parent/child and how many were sponsored by an approved proposer

Of the 2228 Syrians granted a visa as part of the 2015-16 annual Humanitarian Programme:

- 1197 were proposed by an immediate¹ or close family member².
- 24 were proposed by an Approved Proposing Organisation through the CPP.

Notes:

An immediate family member includes:

- spouse or de facto partner
- dependent child or stepchild younger than 18 years of age
- parent or step-parent if you are younger than 18.
