1) Number of applications that were outstanding on 01/07/2018

As at 30 June 2018, there were 5,215 Australian citizenship by conferral applications on-hand (includes primary and dependent applicants) for Iranian nationals.

2) Number of new applications made between 01/07/2018 - 30/06/2019

Between 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019, there were 2,881 Australian citizenship by conferral applications lodged (includes primary and dependent applicants) by Iranian nationals.

3) Number of applications approved between 1/07/2018 and 30/06/2019

Between 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019, 2,570 Australian citizenship applications were approved (includes primary and dependent applicants) for Iranian nationals.

4) Number of applicants who attended citizenship ceremony and received Australian citizenship by conferral between 1/07/2018 and 30/06/2019

In 2018-19, 2,740 Iranian nationals were conferred Australian citizenship at citizenship ceremonies.

5) Number of applications refused between 1/07/2018 and 30/06/2019

Between 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019, 170 Australian citizenship applications were refused (includes prim and dependent applicants) for Iranian nationals.

6) Number of applications that were outstanding on 1/07/2019.

As at 30 June 2019, there were 5,323 Australian citizenship by conferral applications on-hand (includ primary and dependent applicants) for Iranian nationals.
