Description: This incident report is being raised by Detainee Service Manager (DSM) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) following an incident alleged Sexual Assault on the 19th May 2019.

At 1325 hours Detainee s. 47F(1) reported to Detainee Service Officer (DSO) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) that s. 47F(1) want to see GP as my arse hurts and I think someone did something to it last night. On questioning from DSO s. 22(1)(a) believes it could have been s. 47F(1) room mate but s. 47F(1) wasnt sure or specific.

On receiving the information the detainee was escorted to an interview room to await medical examination form IHMS.

At 1335 hours Facilities Operation Manager (FOM) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) reported the incident to ABF on call Duty Manager s. 22(1)(a)(ii) as an alleged assault sexual.

At 1405 FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) called Serco National Duty Manager s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and reported the alleged incident.

At 1411 hours International Health Medical Services (IHMS) Nurse s. 22(1)(a)(ii) examined s. 47F(1) speaking to s. 47F(1) and assessing s. 47F(1) in regards to the incident. IHMS s. 22(1) offered s. 47F(1) a physical examination to which s. 47F(1) agreed.

IHMS s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and IHMS Clinician Nurse s. 22(1)(a)(ii) conducted a physical examination of the alleged affected area.

Following the examination of s. 47F(1) IHMS s. 22(1) reports that no evidence of physical trauma to the area indicated appears to be present.

At 1416 IHMS s. 22(1)(a)(ii) briefed FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) recommending the detainee not be placed back in the same residential area due to the detainee mental health and other safety related concerns if possible be placed in a room apart from other detainees.

IHMS reports that the claim made by s. 47F(1) may be related to s. 47F(1) mental health and that no evidence of physical trauma or harm was apparent. IHMS did not initiate PSP for s. 47F(1) at this time.

At 1422 Hours FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) interviewed s. 47F(1) in the IHMS Clinic.

FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) asked s. 47F(1) what had occurred to s. 47F(1)

s. 47F(1) stated s. 47F(1) woke up and felt likes s. 47F(1) was different when s. 47F(1) woke up.

s. 47F(1) stated that a voice s. 47F(1) in s. 47F(1) head told s. 47F(1) that s. 47F(1) room mate may have fingered s. 47F(1)



Description: This report is being generated by Facility Operations Manager (FOM) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) at Melbourne Immigration Transit Accommodation (MITA). On the 11th day of June 2019 at 1510hrs approximately, Australian Border Force Officers s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and s. 22(1)(a)(ii) engaged in a routine conversation with Detainee s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1). During the conversation s. 47F(1) made an allegation that s. 47F(1) was being inappropriately touched by other detainees for the past approximately 3 months. s. 47F(1) alleged that detainee s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1) was the main perpetrator, but there were numerous others and that s. 47F(1) touched s. 47F(1) on the buttock area numerous times. ABF Officers s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and s. 22(1)(a)(ii) reporting the allegation to FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) at 1530hrs and FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) arranged a follow up interview with s. 47F(1) at 1540hrs to ascertain further details of the allegation. FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and DSO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) spoke with s. 47F(1) where s. 47F(1) stated that s. 47F(1) had been experiencing this type of behaviour for almost 3 months, however could not pin point any exact timings. s. 47F(1) stated that s. 47F(1) often joked with s. 47F(1) telling s. 47F(1) that s. 47F(1) would do sexually orientated actions and stated the words "fuck him". s. 47F(1) stated that what may be a joke to s. 47F(1) and other detainees was no longer funny and s. 47F(1) didn't like the references or being touched on the buttocks. s. 47F(1) was asked if s. 47F(1) would like a referral to be made to the Police, however declined stating that s. 47F(1) did not want this and that there was no physical evidence. s. 47F(1) was asked what s. 47F(1) believed would be the most appropriate options to resolve the situation and asked s. 47F(1) if mediation could be performed to make it clear to s. 47F(1) that s. 47F(1) actions were not funny and were not being perceived as a joke, however s. 47F(1) again declined stating this would not help. FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) then asked s. 47F(1) if s. 47F(1) would be happy to move to another compound and s. 47F(1) stated that the only compound s. 47F(1) was happy to move to would be Erskine and decline relocation to any other compound. Residential Manager s. 22(1)(a)(ii) was advised of the Incident by FOM s. 22(1)(a)(ii) at 1630hrs approximately and agreed that the best immediate course of action would be to place s. 47F(1) onto monitoring at 1 hourly interval to monitor any interactions. s. 47F(1) was advised of the proposed course of action and was satisfied with the immediate intervention and that s. 47F(1) would advise if any further instances occurred. s. 47F(1) has been placed onto Enhanced Monitoring 60 minutes. Further updates will be provided s. 47F(1).

At approximately 0735 hours Detainee Service Officer (DSO) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) initiated a code black (officer needs assistance) at the officer's station of Mackenzie Compound due to detainee s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1).

At approximately 0735 hours Detainee s. 47F(1) approached the officer's station for what appeared to be no reason at all and began saying to the s. 22(1)(a)(ii) DSO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) 'I am going to rape you, I am going to bash you' s. 47F(1) then turned to DSO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and said 'I am going to fuck you in the arse' DSO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) requested that s. 47F(1) move away from the officer's station and to not speak to staff like that. Detainee s. 47F(1) then grabbed Serco cleaner s. 22(1)(a)(ii) by the arm and attempted to bite s. 47F(1) DSO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) placed s. 47F(1) between the detainee and the cleaner to stop detainee from trying to harm s. 47F(1).

Emergency Response Team (ERT) officers then arrived on site and spoke with detainee s. 47F(1) and moved s. 47F(1) on.

Detainee was reminded of s. 47F(1) rights and responsibilities while in detention and that abusing staff is unacceptable.

Code black was stood down at 0741 hours.

Trigger IMP was completed.

Australian Border Force officer went to engage with Ms s. 47F(1) about the allegation and provided the following feedback.

At 15.20 hours, ABF officers s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and s. 22(1)(a)(ii) met with detainee s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1) at the BRP accommodation. s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1) had reported to Serco staff that s. 47F(1) had been sexual assaulted.

ABF Officers s. 47F(1) and s. 22(1)(a)(ii) engaged with s. 47F(1) while walking in the compound and asked if s. 22(1)(a)(ii) had any information s. 47F(1) would like to share with ABF. s. 47F(1) explained s. 47F(1) wanted to see s. 47F(1) dog who acts as s. 47F(1) medical service dog.

Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) prompted s. 47F(1) if s. 47F(1) wanted to share any particular information with ABF regarding any Serco staff or experiences which may have occurred recently. s. 47F(1) paused and then wanted to walk in the opposite direction away from Serco staff, then disclosed that a s. 22(1)(a)(ii) Serco officer had opened the bathroom door whilst s. 47F(1) was using the toilet 'with my pants around my ankles'. s. 47F(1) explained that the s. 22(1)(a)(ii) Serco officer 'walked in on me' when s. 47F(1) needed to use the bathroom whilst at medical.

Last week (date/time unknown) s. 47F(1) stated that s. 47F(1) had asked the Serco officer to drive s. 47F(1) back from medical to s. 47F(1) accommodation at the BRP so s. 47F(1) could use the bathroom there, however s. 47F(1) alleges the Serco officer made inappropriate remarks and was escorted to the medical restrooms. Whilst in the bathroom, s. 47F(1) alleges the officer opened the door, s. 47F(1) asked s. 47F(1) 'do you mind, pardon?', s. 47F(1) then closed the door.

s. 47F(1) stated s. 47F(1) reported the incident to a s. 22(1)(a)(ii) officer and discussed with the BRP Manager.

s. 47F(1) stated the same s. 22(1)(a)(ii) Serco officer was in s. 47F(1) unit with a s. 22(1)(a)(ii) officer for three hours as part of the constant monitoring. s. 47F(1) was under the impression s. 47F(1) would be monitored by s. 22(1)(a)(ii) officers only not s. 22(1)(a)(ii) as s. 47F(1) has an 'issue with s. 22(1)(a)(ii)' due the previous experiences with s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1).

s. 47F(1) advised s. 47F(1) always has s. 22(1)(a)(ii) officers but on this occasion it was a s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and a s. 22(1)(a)(ii) s. 47F(1) was able to point s. 47F(1) out and identify s. 47F(1) to the ABF officers during our conversation, stating that s. 47F(1) 'is always disgruntled with me, nothing I do seems to be right'.
