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1. A total of 5 STC stakeholders have now been tested and 4 are negative. We understand that one stakeholder who provided one-on-one whilst 5.47F(1) was in isolation has tested positive, however final confirmation from the TB unit is awaited. The remainder of the 14 in the original cohort are still undergoing tracing by the relevant state public health authorities.

2. In addition to this group of close contacts, a total of 5 additional stakeholder contacts are now being advised to also undergo screening. This is based upon new advice we have obtained from the QLD TB Unit. Note that these persons were not originally advised to us by the QLD TB Unit as requiring testing.

A teacher who self-presented for testing upon return to Australia has also returned a positive result and this has prompted the public health authorities to include the teachers 5. 22(1)(a)(ii) in the screening program.






