- I've marked up a number of changes to the horoscope drafts for consideration.
- While I'm happy to keep the main 'you will be turned back' arrow graphic, in the text of the horoscopes, I'd prefer to use 'returned' / 'stopped and returned' s. 47E(d) ' to reflect what actually happens with Sri Lankan boats (for the sake of accuracy [more defensible] and credibility).
- Several of the predictions are focused on financial consequences, which is good, but I'd like to include one about not trusting people smugglers. Maybe 'You will be exploited by a criminal': 'If you unwisely trust someone who offers you illegal travel by boat, they will cheat you and steal your money'.
