- 1. There were **625** people in immigration detention who had previously applied for a protection visa. Of these;
 - o 69 had previously been granted a protection visa.
 - o 461 had previously been refused a protection visa, and
 - o 95 were awaiting an outcome.
- 2. The average length of time in detention for those who had applied for a protection visa was 978 days.
- 3. **106** of such people had been in detention for greater than 5 years (1,825 days)
- 4. **22** of such people had been in detention for greater than 8 years (2,920 days)
