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2. Pending Citizenships applications, awaiting tests, awaiting ceremony since Jan 2020 to date

- As at 31 October 2020, there were **163,832** conferral applications on-hand.
- As at 31 October 2020, there were **117,639** conferral applications on-hand for clients who are likely to require a test appointment.
- As at 31 October 2020, there were **31,473** clients whose applications for citizenship by conferral had been approved and were awaiting a citizenship ceremony.
