<u>Response</u>: The Department does not provide an average response to submitted EOIs for each target sector. Each EOI is reviewed on it's own merits. The average response to submitted EOIs is a response for Invites (to apply) and Not Invite (did not meet) emails and is a standard response regardless of the target sector, the only different information is personal identifiers. Due to privacy reasons, a further response cannot be provided.
