Border Measures can confirm that a total of 58 Subclass 300 – Prospective Marriage visa holders had a travel exemption approved between 28 September and 31 December 2020.

Of these:

- 50 were determined to be Immediate family members of an Australian citizen or permanent resident; and
- 8 were approved for an exemption on compassionate and compelling grounds
