Note 2: The processing time is calculated from the date of lodgement to the date of the original refusal, if there is one, else decision date. Applications decided is based on visas granted or refused.

Note 3: The upper on-hand age category for visa applications is "12 months or more". Requests for data with an on-hand age of between 6 and 24 months have been taken as "over 6 months".
