- 1. The Skilled Nominated (subclass 190) nominated visa allocation for the Queensland Government is available at: https://immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/what-we-do/migration-program-planning-levels
- 2. Over the 2020-2021 Program Year (as at 26 February 2021), 512 Skilled Nominated (subclass 190) visas have been granted (404 visas granted onshore, 108 visas granted offshore) where the Queensland Government has nominated the applicant.
- 3. State and Territory nominated visa allocations are not broken down by client location (ie onshore / offshore).
