Question 1:

For each financial year commencing 2010, how many people were (recorded separately) involuntarily or voluntarily removed from Australia who had, in the past:

- held a protection visa or humanitarian visa; or
- · been found to satisfy criteria for a protection or humanitarian visa but for character exclusions, or
- Had a positive ITOA finding,

regardless of whether a subsequent finding had been made regarding international obligations.

Question 2:

For each financial year commencing 2014, how many people were resettled in a third country (a country other than their country of nationality) who had previously had a visa cancelled or refused under s 501 of the Migration Act 1958?

Response:

No one in the regional processing cohort who has been resettled in a third country has had a visa cancelled or refused pursuant to s501 of the Act.
