The total number of applicants, as at 19 February 2021, that had been approved for conferral of Citizenship and were awaiting to attend a ceremony in the Willoughby council of Sydney.

The number of citizenship ceremony attendees from February 2021 to June 2021 for the Willoughby area, outstanding number of applicants at 16 June 2021, that have been approved for conferral of Citizenship and are awaiting to attend a ceremony in the Willoughby council of Sydney.

Response:

As at 19 February 2021, there were 492 people whose applications for Australian citizenship (conferral) had been approved and who were waiting to attend an Australian citizenship ceremony at Willoughby City Council (NSW).

From 1 February 2021 to 31 May 2021, there were 101 people who acquired Australian citizenship at ceremonies conducted by Willoughby City Council (NSW).

As at 2 July 2021, there were 594 people whose applications for Australian citizenship (conferral) had been approved and who were waiting to attend an Australian citizenship ceremony at Willoughby City Council (NSW).
