Question 4:

In relation to 1(c) and (d) above, the number of months between lodgement and decision on each application – i.e. the average processing time from lodgement to decision.

The Department of Home Affairs does not publish average processing times for Child and Orphan Relatives from lodgement to decision for individual applications.

As at 30/06/2021:

- The processing time for a Child (Subclass 101) visa application was approximately 14 Months.
- The processing time for an Orphan Relative (Subclass 117) visa application (Subclass 101) was approximately 51 Months.

Note: Processing times are not available for Orphan Relative (Subclass 837) visa applications.

Caveat

- As lodged, granted and finalised data is drawn from a dynamic system environment, the information in the responses above are correct at the time of clearance and figures may differ slightly from previous or future reporting.

- Regarding Immigration data, the Department's current policy is to mask numbers which are less than five as <5, noting we are reviewing the confidentiality method for the future.
