There have been **no SHEV UMA's** that have applied for a SHEV pathway visa and have been granted.

The SHEV pathway gives some SHEV holders working and/or studying in regional areas the option to apply for certain visas (including some permanent visas) in Australia see list of visas under the SHEV pathway. The pathway is only applicable to Unauthorised Maritime Arrival (UMA) SHEV holders, as they are barred from making a valid application for a visa while in Australia (other than for a TPV/SHEV) by Section 46A of the Migration Act. There may be other instances where SHEV holders are granted non-protection visas, such as if they apply for a visa while offshore.

There have been **7 SHEV UMA's** that have applied for another visa other than a SHEV and have been found to be invalid due to s46A of the Migration Act
