

Freedom of Information Request: FA 22/02/00122

Since the passing of the Australian Citizenship Act 2007, to 31 December 2021, a total of 59 citizens have had their Australian citizenship revoked – 58 under the Australian Citizenship Act 2007 and one under the Citizenship Act 1948.

NOTE: Of these 59 persons, 16 had their citizenship revoked due to migration or citizenship-related fraud. Departmental reporting systems do not reflect whether these persons held dual citizenship, as revocation in the circumstances of section 34(2)(b)(i) and/or section 34(2)(b)(iii) of the Act is permitted even if it would render the person stateless.
