2. As data is drawn from a dynamic system environment, the information is correct at the time of clearance and figures may differ slightly from previous or future reporting;
3. Reference to 'application' in this report includes primary visa applicants and secondary visa applicants.
4. The number of Partner (Temporary) (Subclass 820) visa applications reported as finalised in Table 2 is not drawn from the same data set of applications lodged in the same period reported in Table 1, as departmental systems do not capture this information in a manner than can be reported on using the same data set.
5. 'On hand' denotes valid applications awaiting finalisation/outcome.
6. Data used in this report are drawn from a dynamic source. As a result, a figure appearing in this report relating to a previous period may show minor variation when comparing with a previously published report;
7. Reference to 'application' means applications lodged by primary visa applicants only;
8. Processing times are calculated on application decisions only (granted and refused applications);
9. What is a percentile? A percentile is a measure used in statistics indicating the value below which a given percentage of observations in a group of observations falls. For instance, processing times as at the 50th percentile means that 50 per cent of applications finalised globally were finalised in the stated time or earlier.
