



The 8503 (or No Further Stay) condition means:

That the holder of the visa on which the condition has been imposed will not, after entering Australia, be entitled to be granted any other visa¹, while the holder remains in Australia.

The effect of this visa condition is that it will not be possible for you to apply to remain in Australia beyond the authorised period of stay shown on your visa label.

¹ Except in extremely limited circumstances which are outside your control, or to engage Australia's protection obligation under the 1951 Convention relating to the status of Refugees.

Declaration

Having read the above notes, I declare that:

- *I understand that the effect of this visa condition is that it will not be possible for me to apply to remain in Australia beyond the authorised date on my visa label;*
- *I acknowledge that I am required to depart Australia on or before this date;*
- *I hereby acknowledge that I understand the restriction that Condition 8503 places on me;*
- *I will advise my sponsor (if any) regarding the imposition of the condition to ensure that they understand that such a condition is attached to my visa.*
