

Australian Government response to the Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee report:

New Skilled Regional Visas (Consequential Amendments) Bill 2019 [Provisions]

Recommendations

Recommendation 1: The committee recommends that the Senate pass the bill, subject to resolution of the motion to disallow the Migration Amendment (New Skilled Regional Visas) Regulations 2019.
Response:
The Government notes this recommendation. However, given the passage of time since the report was tabled, a substantive Government response is no longer appropriate.
Australian Greens additional comments
Recommendation 1:
1.7 That disability services referred to by schedule 1, item 7 of this Bill be grandfathered for all Special Category Visas issued prior to enactment of this Bill.
Response:

Recommendation 2:
1.10 That the Government develops a comprehensive regional policy to support the settlement of migrants in rural and regional communities, which considers, inter alia, the needs of employees, employers, industries, public services and infrastructure, and broader regional communities.
