My suggestion is that Australians be better assisted to develop their own emergency plan for dealing with natural disasters by the provision of an artificial intelligence interactive guided app that takes them through the steps of such a plan as they apply to that individual person or family and the circumstances and area in which they are living and the nature of the disaster. The plan should of course be capable of being printed out, in case internet services are lost in a disaster.

In my opinion generalised documented disaster planning advice on how to create a plan tend to contain too much information not relevant for the individual situation.

The plans customization for the individual can include things like:

- number of people in the family and ages and mobility
- pets and other animals
- is egress via car or on foot
- when to remain in place
- what to take (for that size family and pets) including what goes in your emergency bag(s)
- prior route planning
- disaster warning monitoring
- location of nearly safe places
- communication with others
- choosing a destination and so on.
