

Contributory Parents Visa (Subclass 143) applicants can be a workforce, can help children work and raise grandchildren for the next generation's workforce. They are high ranking people in their countries. They can not be a burden to Australia. They are well educated, healthy and not poor. They educate children in Australia and pay a visa cost \$100,000+.

They are a new generation different from typical immigrant parents who are sick, old and poor.

It was less than 24 months until 2017 but more than 120,000 of backlogs and the cap is only 8,500/year. It will take 15+ years with \$100,000+ while the Partner Visa does not pay it. This slow process hurt them and it was worsened by Covid-19 especially mothers with babies.

Please remove the cap for the Contributory Parent Visa (SC 143) just like the Partner Visa.

Or

Please raise the cap to 20,000+ per year for the Contributory Parents Visa(143). It still takes 5+ years for the Contributory Parent Visa applicants.

My parents have been in the queue since Dec 2019. It is a very long waiting period. Their skills can be utilised in the Australia workforce and I can be more efficient in contributing to the economy knowing that there are grandparents taking care of my children.
