About this report

This report provides an overview of the number of Illegal Maritime Arrivals (IMAs) who have been granted a Bridging E visa (BVE) to allow them to remain lawfully in Australia while their immigration status is being resolved.

The data is sourced from several departmental processing and recording systems. All reasonable efforts have been made to ensure the accuracy of this information; however, it is subject to revision.

The report presents some basic statistics on IMAs who had been granted BVEs and were living in the community at the time of reporting.

The Department of Home Affairs has a policy of not publishing figures, for individuals, which total less than ten. This is done to protect the privacy of individuals.

The 2021 September quarter report is expected to be released in early November 2021.

Release of IMAs on Bridging E visa (BVE)

Key program concepts

Since 25 November 2011, successive Ministers have used their non-compellable, non-delegable intervention power under s195A of the *Migration Act 1958* to grant a Bridging E Visa (BVE) to some illegal maritime arrivals (IMAs).

Overall program numbers and current location by State and Territory


Between 25 November 2011 and 30 June 2021, 37,473 IMAs had been granted BVEs. Of these IMAs, 11,891 were residing in the Australian community as at 30 June 2021 (9610 with a BVE in effect and 2281 awaiting grant of a further BVE). The remaining 25,582 IMAs had either been granted a substantive visa, departed Australia, returned to immigration detention or were deceased.

BVE holders are free to choose where they live. As at 30 June 2021, the largest numbers of IMAs were in Victoria (VIC), followed by New South Wales (NSW), Queensland (QLD), South Australia (SA), Western Australia (WA), Australian Capital Territory (ACT), Northern Territory (NT), and Tasmania (TAS).
