

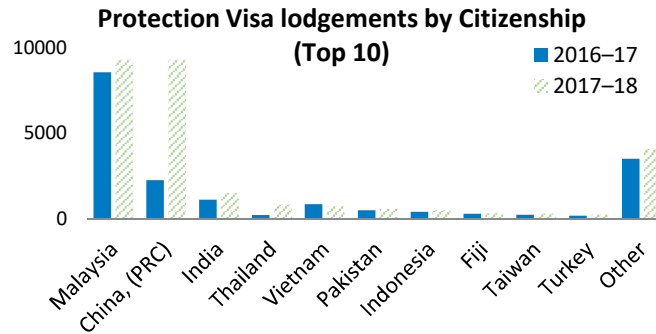

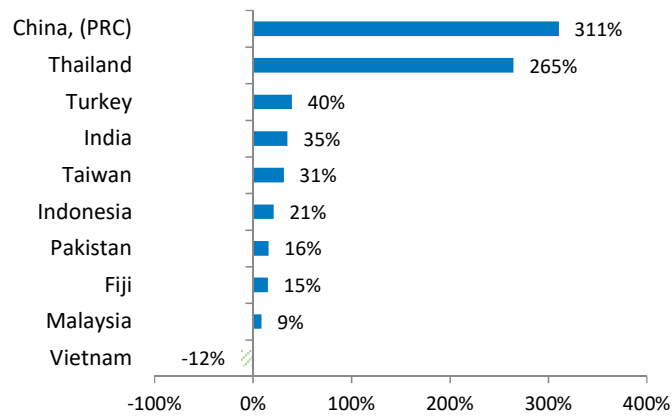


The above graph shows a comparison of Protection visa lodgements by top 10 Citizenships, 2016–17 and 2017–18.
