

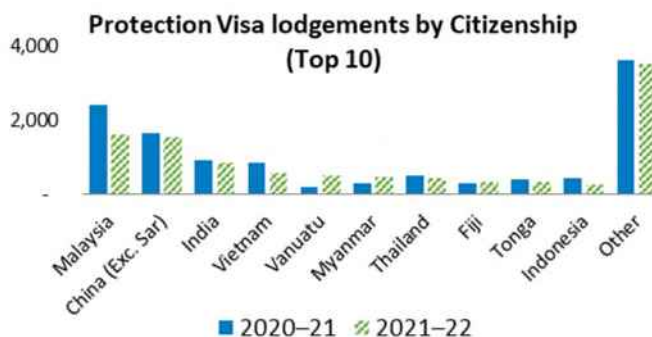

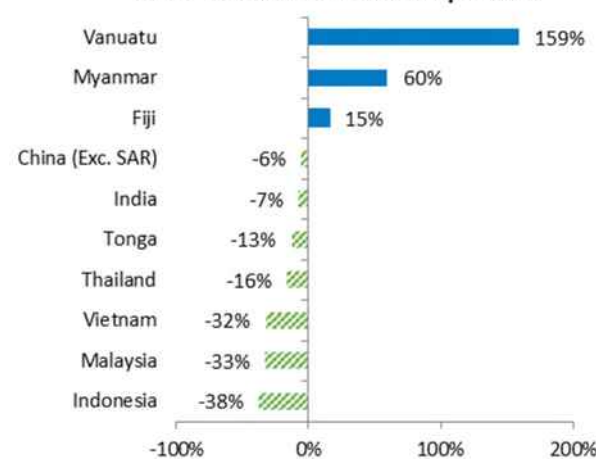


The above graph shows a comparison of Protection visa lodgements by top 10 Citizenships, 2020–21 and 2021–22.
