Pathways to permanent residence

In the 2020-21 program year to 30 September 2020:

- 3,910 temporary resident (skilled) visa holders were granted permanent residence or a provisional visa, an decrease of 68.0 per cent compared with the same period in the previous program year (12,250);
- the vast majority of permanent visa grants to TSS and subclass 457 visa holders were in the economic migration stream (70.2 per cent).
