About this report

This report provides quarterly data about the Visitor visa program administered by the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (the department). The report has been produced to assist tourism industry stakeholders and policymakers.

It is expected that this report will be further developed over time to increase and improve information sharing about the Visitor visa program. This report for the quarter ending 30 June 2012 includes a new table showing eligible passports for electronic lodgement of Visitor visa applications and information on some recent key initiatives in the Visitor visa program.

Data is sourced from several departmental visa processing and recording systems. Data can be dynamic and there can be delays in transmission of information from the department's global operations. Variations in figures between this report and previous reports can occur. Due to these issues, figures for the current financial year should always be considered provisional.

Definition of terms

Applicant type:	Under the Migration Regulations 1994 (the Regulations), there are two types of applicants. These are primary applicants and secondary applicants.
Approved Destination Status (ADS):	This scheme facilitates the travel of organised tour groups from the People's Republic of China (PRC) to Australia by approved travel agents. Tourists under the ADS scheme are granted a subcategory of the Tourist (subclass 676) visa and do not require a visa label.
Auto grant:	An automated process by which an electronic visa application is checked against security and immigration risk business rules and, if the automated checks are satisfied, the visa is granted, often within minutes after lodgement. Electronic applications which do not satisfy automated checks are referred for manual assessment by a visa processing officer.
Citizenship country:	The country of citizenship of the visa applicant or visa holder. Where a visa applicant or visa holder has more than one citizenship country, either the citizenship of the travel document or the citizenship nominated by the visa applicant is used.
Decided:	The term used for counts of decisions. See below for definition of "decisions".
Decisions:	An outcome where a decision-maker (including system-generated decision-making) grants or refuses a visa or sponsorship application.
eLodged:	Visa application lodged electronically, by eligible passport holders, via the departmental website. Visas that can be eLodged are the eVisitor (subclass 651) visa and the Tourist (subclass 676) visa (also known as the e676).
ETA:	Electronic Travel Authority. An electronic visa available to citizens from low risk countries. The term "low risk" applies to countries which issue ETA eligible passports. A list of these can be found on the department's website.
Granted:	Unless otherwise specified, the number of visas granted includes primary and review grants.
Lodged:	Lodged is the count of paper applications receipted in a departmental office or submitted electronically.
Offshore:	In this report, the term refers to the location of the client at the time of lodging the application.
On hand:	A visa application, nomination or sponsorship that has not been finalised.
Onshore:	In this report, refers to the location of the client at the time the application was lodged. An onshore applicant may already hold a visa of the same kind or may be applying for another type of visa.
Visa applicant:	Used to refer to clients applying for a visa. Unless otherwise specified, the term covers both primary and secondary applicants.
Visa holders in Australia:	The number of visa holders lawfully in Australia. This is not a count of all valid visas, as a number of visa holders may be outside Australia on the snapshot date.

Background to the Visitor visa program

Visitor visa subclasses can be divided into Tourism and Business streams:

Tourism:

- 1. Tourist (Subclass 676) visa. This visa allows people to visit Australia for tourism purposes. This may include a holiday or recreation, or to visit family and friends. This visa can be applied for either onshore or offshore and may also be used for other short-term non-work purposes including study for up to three months. This visa can also be applied for online (known as the "e676") by eligible passport holders.*
- 2. Sponsored Family Visitor (Subclass 679) visa. This visa allows people who are outside of Australia, and have an eligible sponsor in Australia (an eligible relative or Australian Government official willing to sponsor them), to travel to Australia for a holiday and to visit family. This visa is intended for higher risk visitors and contains additional requirements which are designed to provide assurance that the visa holder will comply with their visa conditions and depart Australia before their visa expires. A formal sponsorship is to be completed by an Australian citizen/permanent resident and in some cases a security bond is requested where the decision-maker has residual concerns about the visa applicant's intention to abide by the visa conditions.
- 3. Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) (Visitor) (Subclass 976). This visa is designed for ETA eligible passport holders* who are outside of Australia and who want to visit Australia for tourism purposes. It allows an applicant to stay in Australia for up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant, or for the life of the passport if it is less than 12 months. It can be applied for online, through a travel agent, airline or specialist service provider or at an Australian visa office outside of Australia.
- 4. eVisitor (Subclass 651 Tourist Entrant). This visa is designed for people outside of Australia who want to visit Australia for tourism purposes. It can only be lodged online and is available to certain European nationals*, as it was introduced in October 2008 to meet the Australian Government's undertaking to have reciprocal short stay travel arrangements with the European Union. It allows a stay of up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant.

* Note: For e676, ETA and eVisitor eligible passports, please refer to the table on the next page.

Business:

- 5. Business (Short Stay) (Subclass 456) visa. This visa allows business people to make a short business visit to Australia for up to three months during their visa validity period. Business activities may include attending meetings, conferences, site visits, exploring business opportunities or, in limited circumstances, specialised non-ongoing work. The visa holder cannot engage in work in Australia that might otherwise be carried out by an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
- 6. Sponsored Business Visitor (Short Stay) (Subclass 459) visa. This visa has the same purpose as the Subclass 456 visa but requires the business person to have an approved sponsor in Australia (a representative from an approved organisation or an Australian government official).
- 7. ETA (Business Entrant Short Validity) (Subclass 977). This visa is designed for ETA eligible passport holders* who are outside of Australia and who want to make a short business visit to Australia. It allows an applicant to stay in Australia for up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant, or for the life of the passport if it is less than 12 months. It can be applied for online, through a travel agent, airline or specialist service provider or at an Australian visa office outside of Australia.
- 8. ETA (Business Entrant Long Validity) (Subclass 956). This visa has the same purpose as the Subclass 977 visa but is valid for the life of the passport.
- 9. eVisitor (Subclass 651 Business Entrant). This visa is designed for people outside of Australia who want to visit Australia for short term business purposes. It can only be lodged online and is available to certain European nationals*, as it was introduced in October 2008 to meet the Australian Government's undertaking to have reciprocal short stay travel arrangements with the European Union. It allows a stay of up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant.
- 10. Superyacht Crew (Subclass 488) visa. This temporary visa allows the crew of superyachts to enter Australia to undertake the usual day to day routine maintenance or business of these vessels while at sea. The applicant may be either inside or outside of Australia when the visa is granted. The visa is a multiple entry visa and permits the visa holder to work onboard these vessels in Australia for up to one year, with the option to extend their stay. Additionally, the crew must be sponsored by an owner or captain of the superyacht who is an approved superyacht crew sponsor.

Background to the Visitor visa program - continued

Family members

Tourist Visitors (except those applying for Sponsored Family Visitor visas) must lodge separate applications, unless they are included in the passport of the main applicant.

Business Visitors and Sponsored Family Visitors can apply to have partners and dependent children under the age of eighteen accompany them to Australia.

Visa requirements

To be eligible for a Visitor visa, applicants must have a genuine intention to stay in Australia temporarily as a visitor (for tourism or business purposes).

Applicants must also meet certain health and character requirements, and may be asked to undergo a health examination, and/or provide police certificates for each country they have lived in for 12 months or more over the last ten years since turning 16.

In order to meet the financial requirements for the grant of a Visitor visa, applicants must be able to demonstrate that they have access to sufficient funds to cover themselves (and their family where relevant) during their stay in Australia, including health insurance where required. They may be asked to provide evidence of funds.

Ability to work

Work on a Tourist visa is not permitted. This is enforced by a mandatory "no work" condition imposed on all Tourist visas.

Work on a Business Visitor visa is permitted in very limited circumstances where the work is non-ongoing (no more than six weeks for the validity of the visa) and highly skilled in nature.

A Business Visitor visa holder cannot engage in work in Australia that might otherwise be carried out by an Australian citizen or permanent resident.

Where a person is found to be working in breach of their visa conditions, they may face visa cancellation and be subject to an exclusion period.

Ability to study

Tourist visa holders may study for up to three months. This may be an award or non-award course, however, the entire course must not be longer than 3 months in duration.

Business Visitor visa holders may undertake informal study for up to three months, where it is related to their profession and does not lead to a formal award (other than a language training program).

Volunteering

Tourist visa holders may be able to work as a volunteer where the work is genuinely voluntary and no remuneration is received in return for the activities.

Background to the Visitor visa program - continued

Extending stay

Visitor visas cannot be 'extended'. However Visitor visa holders may extend their stay in Australia by applying for another visa, such as a Tourist (subclass 676) visa, at least two weeks before their current visa expires.

An additional visa may be granted if the applicant has complied with the conditions of their previous visa, meets all eligibility criteria for this visa, and does not have a 'No further stay' condition on their current visa.

It is not possible to apply for a Business Visitor visa in Australia.

Visa refusals

A decision to refuse a Visitor visa application is made when the delegate of the Minister for Immigration and Citizenship is not satisfied that the applicant meets the legal criteria for grant of a visa. When refusing a visa application, the department provides an applicant, or their agent, with a written decision record that sets out the reason for the decision.

Reasons for refusal of Visitor visa applications may include:

- failure to meet financial, health or character requirements; and/or
- failure to satisfy the department that the applicant is a genuine visitor.

Processing standards

The department aims to finalise 75 per cent of Visitor visa applications within the following timeframes:

- for non-sponsored visitors where the application is lodged onshore one working day for low risk applicants and one week for high risk applicants;
- for non-sponsored visitors where the application is lodged offshore one working day for low risk applicants and one month for high risk applicants;
- for sponsored visitors (all sponsored visitor applications are lodged onshore) 1.5 months.

The processing service standard applies where all documents are submitted with the application form. The process may be delayed if applications are incomplete or if additional information is required, including health examination and/or character checks.

Note: Low risk refers to persons holding Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) eligible passports, and high risk refers to persons who are not ETA eligible.

Recent key initiatives

- In September 2011, the Department began publishing Modified Non-Return Rate (MNRR) data on its public website at www.immi.gov.au/media/statistics/quarterly-report-20110930.htm. MNRR is a key indicator of Visitor visa compliance and is considered by visa processing officers when determining the level of risk posed by a visa applicant. Publication of MNRR data provides greater transparency of the decision-making process for clients and other external stakeholders.
- On 1 March 2012, the Department commenced a six month trial allowing selected Approved Destination Status (ADS) agents in China to lodge independent Tourist visa applications and receive streamlined processing.
- To support tourism in new markets, in 2011-12 the Department expanded access to the online version of the Tourist (subclass 676) visa, known as 'e676', to citizens of Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Croatia, the Maldives and Turkey (officials only). The e676 offers benefits including electronic payment of the visa application charge, quicker decision-making and label-free travel.
- The Department has expanded the take up of travel without a visa label being placed in passports, with Indonesia, Singapore and Vietnam agreeing to allow their citizens to travel to Australia without having a visa label. The majority of visitors to Australia travel label-free and the department is working to further expand this opportunity to other visitors.

Executive Summary

Key Points

- Tourism Visitor visa applications remained steady in 2011-12 (3 193 936) compared to 2010-11 (3 193 224).
 Fewer lodgements by citizens of the United Kingdom, Japan, Germany and South Korea were offset by continued growth in lodgements by citizens of China (up 26.3% to 336 834), India (up 9.1% to 106 556) and Indonesia (up 6.3% to 77 193).
- The United Kingdom remained the largest source country for tourists to Australia in 2011-12 with 487 029 lodgements. China (336 834 lodgements) has replaced the United States of America (305 053 lodgements) as the second largest source country.
- 478 581 business Visitor visa applications were lodged in 2011-12. This is a 4.9% increase over 2010-11 (456 168) and can be partially attributed to an increase in applications from citizens of the United States of America (up 9.3% to 68 663).
- The grant rate for Visitor visas for the quarter ending 30 June 2012 remained stable at 96.9%, compared with 97% for the same quarter in 2011.
- In the quarter ending 30 June 2012, there were 22 587 subclass 676 visas granted under the ADS scheme. This is the highest number of visas granted under the scheme for this quarter in the last five years.
- On 30 June 2012, there were 202 265 Visitor visa holders in Australia.

1 Applications lodged

3 672 517 Visitor visa applications were lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June. This is a 0.6% increase over 2010-11 (3 649 392).

3 193 936 tourism Visitor visa applications were lodged in 2011-12 which is consistent with 2010-11 (3 193 224). A decrease in applications from citizens of the United Kingdom (down 9%), Japan (down 6.3%), Germany (down 5.9%) and South Korea (down 5.2%) has been offset by continued growth in lodgements by citizens of China (up 26.3% to 336 834), India (up 9.1% to 106 556) and Indonesia (up 6.3% to 77 193).

Sponsored Family Visitor (subclass 679) visa applications fell by 12.2% in 2011-12, likely as a result of clients choosing to apply for the more streamlined Tourist (subclass 676) visa.

The United Kingdom remained the largest source country for tourism visitors to Australia in 2011-12 with 487 029 lodgements. China (336 834 lodgements) has replaced the United States of America (305 053 lodgements) as the second largest source country.

478 581 business Visitor visa applications were lodged in 2011-12. This is a 4.9% increase over 2010-11 (456 168) and can be partially attributed to an increase in applications from citizens of the United States of America (up 9.3% to 68 663).

788 297 Visitor visa applications were lodged in the quarter ending 30 June 2012. This is higher than the same quarters in 2011 (760 639) and 2010 (769 238).

2 Visas granted

3 558 737 Visitor visas were granted in 2011-12. This is a 0.5% increase over 2010-11 (3 540 774).

3 095 160 tourism Visitor visas were granted in 2011-12. This is only 0.1% lower than 2010-11 (3 098 023). A 4.3% decrease in ETA subclass 976 visa grants (down from 1 977 882 to 1 892 494) has been softened by an 11.6% increase in subclass 676 grants (up from 732 744 to 817 520).

463 577 business Visitor visas were granted in 2011-12. This is a 4.7% increase over 2011 (442 751). This can be partially attributed to a 7.3% increase in ETA subclass 977 grants (up from 179 300 to 192 477) compared to 2010-11.

756 729 Visitor visas were granted in the quarter ending 30 June 2012. This is higher than the same quarters in 2011 (727 564) and 2010 (743 363).

3 Grant rates

The grant rate for Visitor visas visas for the quarter ending 30 June 2012 remained stable at 96.9%, compared with 97% for the same quarter in 2011.

4 Auto grant rates for eLodged Applications

The auto grant rate for offshore eLodged Tourist (subclass 676) visas for the quarter ending 30 June 2012 was 54.8%. This was higher than the same quarter in 2011 (42.1%).

The auto grant rate for eVisitor Tourist Entrant (subclass 651) visas for the quarter ending 30 June 2012 was 88.8%. This was higher than the same quarter in 2011 (85.7%).

Executive Summary - continued

The auto grant rate for eVisitor Business Entrant (subclass 651) visas for the quarter ending 30 June 2012 was 84.3%. This was higher than the same quarter in 2011 (78.7%).

These improvements in auto grant rates reflect refinements to processes for identifying lower risk applicants.

5 Processing times

During the quarter ending 30 June 2012, 75% of offshore Tourist (subclass 676) visa applications were processed within nine calendar days, 75% of onshore Tourist (subclass 676) visa applications were processed within 13 calendar days and 75% of Business (Short Stay) (subclass 456) visa applications were processed within five calendar days. These processing times are consistent with the same quarter in 2011.

During the quarter ending 30 June 2012, 75% of Sponsored Family Visitor (subclass 679) visa applications were processed within 37 calendar days, compared to 56 calendar days for the same quarter in 2011. This shorter processing time has resulted from improved work practices by visa processing staff.

Processing times increase if applications are incomplete or if additional information is required, including health examinations and/or character checks.

6 Applications on hand

On 30 June 2012, there were 50 660 Visitor visa applications on hand. This is a 12.1% increase over the 45 163 applications on hand on the same date in 2011. This reflects an increase in the number of paper Tourist (subclass 676) visa applications lodged in the quarter ending 30 June 2012.

To ensure that onshore applicants do not become unlawful because their existing visas expire before a new visa is granted, bridging visas are granted until a decision on their application is made.

7 Visa holders In Australia

On 30 June 2012, there were 202 265 Visitor visa holders in Australia. This is 21.8% higher than the 166 025 Visitor visa holders in Australia on the same date in 2011.

Tourist (subclass 676) visa holders made up the largest cohort with 89 665 visa holders in Australia, followed by ETA subclass 976 with 77 771 visa holders.

The number of Visitor visa holders in Australia at any given time is influenced by a range of factors, including exchange rates, holiday periods, major events and a general increase in tourists from Asia (particularly China).

8 Approved Destination Status (ADS)

137 797 Tourist (subclass 676) visas were granted under the ADS scheme in 2011-12. This is a 24.6% increase over 2010-11 (110 609).

In the quarter ending 30 June 2012, there were 22 587 subclass 676 visas granted under the ADS scheme. This is the highest number of visas granted under the scheme for this quarter in the last five years.

ADS grants made up 32.6% of all subclass 676 grants to Chinese tourists in the quarter ending 30 June 2012, a decrease on the previous quarter (53.8%). This reflects a typical decline in group travel following the peak Chinese New Year travel period.


9 Arrivals data

In 2011-12, there were 3 820 663 arrivals on Visitor visas. This is a 0.3% decrease on 2010-11 (3 832 667). Fewer arrivals from the United Kingdom (down 8%), the United States of America (down 3%), Japan (down 5.1%), South Korea (down 4.8%) and Germany (down 5.9%) have been offset by increased arrivals from China (up 20.4% to 451 009), India (up 7.6% to 122 432) and Indonesia (up 5.7% to 106 490).


There were 658 102 arrivals on tourism Visitor visas during the quarter ending 30 June 2012. This was higher than the same quarters in 2011 (655 966) and 2010 (655 499).

There were 121 067 arrivals on business Visitor visas during the quarter ending 30 June 2012. This was higher than the same quarters in 2011 (116 886) and 2010 (113 717).

1.01 Number of Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




1.02 Number of Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year





1.03 Number of Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year




1.04 Number of tourism Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year



1.05 Number of business Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




1.06 Number of business Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year





2.05 Number of tourism Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




2.06 Number of business Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year





2.07 Number of tourism Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year









2.12 Total number of subclass 676 Tourist visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 - comparison with previous four financial years








7.02 Number of Visitor visa holders in Australia as at 30 June 2012 by visa subclass - comparison with same date in previous year







9.01 Number of arrivals for Business stream in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 - comparison with previous four financial years







9.03 Number of Visitor visa arrivals in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year




9.04 Number of arrivals for subclass 456 Business (Short Stay) in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 - comparison with previous four financial years




9.05 Number of arrivals for subclass 651 eVisitor in 2011-12 to 30 June 2012 - comparison with previous three financial years
