### About this report

This report provides quarterly data about the Visitor visa program administered by the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (the department). The report has been produced to assist tourism industry stakeholders and policymakers.

Data is sourced from several departmental visa processing and recording systems. Data can be dynamic and there can be delays in transmission of information from the department's global operations. Variations in figures between this report and previous reports can occur. Due to these issues, figures for the current financial year should always be considered provisional.

#### Definition of terms

Applicant type: Under the Migration Regulations 1994 (the Regulations), there are two types of

applicants. These are primary applicants and secondary applicants.

Approved Destination

Status (ADS):

This scheme facilitates the travel of organised tour groups from the People's Republic of China (PRC) to Australia by approved travel agents. Tourists under the ADS scheme are granted a subcategory of the Tourist (subclass 676) visa and do not

require a visa label.

Auto grant: An automated process by which an electronic visa application is checked against

security and immigration risk business rules and, if the automated checks are

satisfied, the visa is granted, often within minutes after lodgement.

Citizenship country: The country of citizenship of the visa applicant or visa holder. Where a visa applicant

or visa holder has more than one citizenship country, either the citizenship of the travel document used for the visa label or the citizenship nominated by the visa

applicant is used.

Decided: The term used for counts of decisions. See below for definition of "decisions".

Decisions: An outcome where a decision-maker (including system-generated decision-making)

grants or refuses a visa or sponsorship application.

eLodged: Visa application lodged electronically, by eligible passport holders, via the

departmental website. Visas that can be eLodged are the eVisitor (subclass 651) visa

and the Tourist (subclass 676) visa (also known as the e676).

ETA: Electronic Travel Authority. An electronic visa available to citizens from low risk

countries. The term "low risk" applies to countries which issue ETA eligible passports.

A list of these can be found on the department's website.

Granted: Unless otherwise specified, the number of visas granted includes primary and review

grants.

Lodged: Lodged is the count of paper applications receipted in a departmental office or

submitted electronically.

Offshore: In this report, the term refers to the location of the client at the time of lodging the

application.

On hand: A visa application, nomination or sponsorship that has not been finalised.

Onshore: In this report, refers to the location of the client at the time the application was

lodged. An onshore applicant may already hold a visa of the same kind or may be

applying for another type of visa.

Visa applicant: Used to refer to clients applying for a visa. Unless otherwise specified, the term

covers both primary and secondary applicants.

Visa holders in Australia: The number of visa holders lawfully in Australia. This is not a count of all valid visas,

as a number of visa holders may be outside Australia on the snapshot date.

### Background to the Visitor visa program

There are nine Visitor visa subclasses, which can be divided into Tourist and Business streams:

#### Tourist:

- 1. Tourist (subclass 676) visa. This visa allows people to visit Australia for tourism purposes. This may include a holiday or recreation, or to visit family and friends. This visa can be applied for either onshore or offshore and may also be used for other short-term non-work purposes including study for up to three months. This visa can also be applied for online (known as the "e676") by eligible passport holders.
- 2. Sponsored Family Visitor (subclass 679) visa. This visa allows people who are outside of Australia, and have an eligible sponsor in Australia (an eligible relative or Australian Government official willing to sponsor them), to travel to Australia for a holiday and to visit family. This visa is intended for higher risk visitors and contains additional requirements which are designed to provide assurance that the visa holder will comply with their visa conditions and depart Australia before their visa expires. A formal sponsorship is to be completed by an Australian citizen/permanent resident and in some cases a security bond is requested where the decision-maker has residual concerns about the visa applicant's intention to abide by the visa conditions.
- 3. Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) (Visitor) (subclass 976). This visa is designed for ETA eligible passport holders who are outside of Australia and who want to visit Australia for tourism purposes. It allows an applicant to stay in Australia for up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant, or for the life of the passport if it is less than 12 months. It can be applied for online, through a travel agent, airline or specialist service provider or at an Australian visa office outside of Australia.
- 4. eVisitor (subclass 651 Tourist Entrant). This visa is designed for people outside of Australia who want to visit Australia for tourism purposes. It can only be lodged online and is available to certain European nationals, as it was introduced in October 2008 to meet the Australian Government's undertaking to have reciprocal short stay travel arrangements with the European Union. It allows a stay of up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant.
- 5. Superyacht Crew (subclass 488) visa. This temporary visa allows the crew of superyachts to enter Australia to undertake the usual day to day routine maintenance or business of these vessels while at sea. The applicant may be either inside or outside of Australia when the visa is granted. The visa is a multiple entry visa and permits the visa holder to work onboard these vessels in Australia for up to one year, with the option to extend their stay. Additionally, the crew must be sponsored by an owner or captain of the superyacht who is an approved superyacht crew sponsor.

#### **Business:**

- 6. Business (Short Stay) (subclass 456) visa. This visa allows business people to make a short business visit to Australia for up to three months during their visa validity period. Business activities may include attending meetings, conferences, site visits, exploring business opportunities or, in limited circumstances, specialised non-ongoing work. The visa holder cannot engage in work in Australia that might otherwise be carried out by an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
- 7. Sponsored Business Visitor (Short Stay) (subclass 459) visa. This visa has the same purpose as the subclass 456 visa but requires the business person to have an approved sponsor in Australia (a representative from an approved organisation or an Australian government official).
- 8. ETA (Business Entrant Short Validity) (subclass 977). This visa is designed for ETA eligible passport holders who are outside of Australia and who want to make a short business visit to Australia. It allows an applicant to stay in Australia for up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant, or for the life of the passport if it is less than 12 months. It can be applied for online, through a travel agent, airline or specialist service provider or at an Australian visa office outside of Australia.
- 9. ETA (Business Entrant Long Validity) (subclass 956). This visa has the same purpose as the subclass 977 visa but is valid for the life of the passport.
- 10. eVisitor (subclass 651 Business Entrant). This visa is designed for people outside of Australia who want to visit Australia for short term business purposes. It allows online lodgement and is available to eVisitor eligible passport holders. Eligibility is limited to certain European nationals, as the product was introduced in October 2008 to meet the Australian Government's undertaking to have reciprocal short stay travel arrangements with the European Union.

### Background to the Visitor visa program - continued

#### Family members

Tourist Visitors (except those applying for Sponsored Family Visitor visas) must lodge separate applications, unless they are included in the passport of the main applicant.

Business Visitors and Sponsored Family Visitors can apply to have partners and dependent children under the age of eighteen accompany them to Australia.

#### Visa requirements

To be eligible for a Visitor visa, applicants must have a genuine intention to stay in Australia temporarily as a visitor (for tourism or business purposes).

Applicants must also meet certain health and character requirements, and may be asked to undergo a health examination, and/or provide police certificates for each country they have lived in for 12 months or more over the last ten years since turning 16.

In order to meet the financial requirements for the grant of a Visitor visa, applicants must be able to demonstrate that they have access to sufficient funds to cover themselves (and their family where relevant) during their stay in Australia, including health insurance where required. They may be asked to provide evidence of funds.

#### Ability to work

Work on a Tourist visa is not permitted. This is enforced by a mandatory "no work" condition imposed on all Tourist visas

Work on a Business Visitor visa is permitted in very limited circumstances where the work is non-ongoing (no more than six weeks for the validity of the visa) and highly skilled in nature.

A Business Visitor visa holder cannot engage in work in Australia that might otherwise be carried out by an Australian citizen or permanent resident.

Where a person is found to be working in breach of their visa conditions, they may face visa cancellation and be subject to an exclusion period.

#### Ability to study

Tourist visa holders may study for up to three months. This may be an award or non-award course, however, the entire course must not be longer than 3 months in duration.

Business Visitor visa holders may undertake informal study for up to three months, where it is related to their profession and does not lead to a formal award (other than a language training program).

#### Volunteering

Tourist visa holders may be able to work as a volunteer where the work is genuinely voluntary and no remuneration is received in return for the activities.

### Background to the Visitor visa program - continued

#### Visa extensions

Tourist visa holders may extend their stay for tourism purposes by applying for a new visa at least two weeks before their current visa expires.

An additional Tourist visa may be granted if the applicant has complied with the conditions of their previous visa, meets all eligibility criteria for this visa, and does not have a 'No further stay' condition on their current visa.

Business Visitor visa holders cannot extend their stay after they arrive in Australia.

#### Visa refusals

A decision to refuse a Visitor visa application is made when the delegate of the Minister for Immigration and Citizenship is not satisfied that the applicant meets the legal criteria for grant of a visa. When refusing a visa application, the department provides an applicant, or their agent, with a written decision record that sets out the reason for the decision.

Reasons for refusal of Visitor visa applications may include:

- failure to meet financial, health or character requirements; and/or
- failure to satisfy the department that the applicant is a genuine visitor.

#### Processing standards

The department aims to finalise 75 per cent of Visitor visa applications within the following timeframes:

- for non-sponsored visitors where the application is lodged onshore one working day for low risk applicants and one week for high risk applicants;
- for non-sponsored visitors where the application is lodged offshore one working day for low risk applicants and one month for high risk applicants;
- for sponsored visitors (all sponsored visitor applications are lodged onshore) 1.5 months.

The processing service standard applies where all documents are submitted with the application form. The process may be delayed if applications are incomplete or if additional information is required, including health examination and/or character checks.

Note: Low risk refers to persons holding Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) eligible passports, and high risk refers to persons who are not ETA eligible.

### **Executive Summary**

### **Key Points**

- There has been an 11.5% increase in business Visitor visa applications in the September 2011 quarter (123 888) compared to the same quarter in 2010 (111 138). The largest increase was in Business (Short Stay) (subclass 456) visa lodgements which increased 16.8% (53 931 to 62 968). This is the highest number of subclass 456 lodgements for this quarter in the last five years.
- Visitor visa grants decreased by 4.3% in the September 2011 quarter (854 279) compared with the same period in 2010 (892 962). This is largely due to weaker tourist demand from Japan, United Kingdom, United States of America, Malaysia and South Korea.
- There were 26 389 visas granted under the ADS scheme during the September 2011 quarter. This is the highest number of visas granted under the ADS scheme for this quarter in the last four years.

#### 1 Applications lodged

There were 881 688 Visitor visa applications lodged in the September 2011 quarter. This is a 4% decrease in lodgements compared to the same period in 2010 (918 684). This can be primarily attributed to a decrease in tourist applications from citizens of Japan (down 19.2%), United Kingdom (down 12.2%), United States of America (down 13.4%), Malaysia (down 7.2%) and South Korea (down 9.4%).

There were 62 968 Business (Short Stay) (subclass 456) visa applications lodged in the September 2011 quarter. This is 16.8% higher than the same period in 2010 (53 931). This is also the highest number of lodgements for this quarter in the last five years. This can be attributed to ongoing growth in subclass 456 lodgements by Chinese citizens (up 23.4% to 20 625), reflecting strong business ties between China and Australia.

There were 97 086 eVisitor (subclass 651) visa applications lodged in the September 2011 quarter, of which 86 187 were in the tourism stream (down 6.2%) and 10 899 were in the business stream (up 2.8%). This is a 5.2% decrease when compared to the same period in 2010.

Lodgements of Electronic Travel Authority (Visitor) (subclass 976) visa applications in the September 2011 quarter (457 759) were down 11.7% when compared with the same quarter in 2010 (518 157). This is also the lowest number of lodgements for this quarter in the last five years. This could be the result of the strength of the Australian dollar and the continuing impact of the Eurozone financial crisis.

There were 6399 Sponsored Family Visitor (subclass 679) visa applications lodged in the September 2011 quarter. This is the lowest number of lodgements for this quarter in five years and reflects a significant drop in demand from major subclass 679 source countries: Vietnam (down 47.9%); China (down 6.5%); Philippines (down 10.9%) and Lebanon (down 10.4%) compared with the same quarter in 2010. This may be due to the decreased subclass 679 grant rate and the strength of the Australian dollar.

There were 207 406 Tourist (subclass 676) visa applications lodged in the September 2011 quarter. This is the highest number of lodgements for this quarter over the last five years. This can be primarily attributed to the 25.8% increase in lodgements by Chinese nationals when compared to the same quarter in 2010 (from 55 191 to 69 426), reflecting continued economic prosperity and a fast growing middle class in China.

There were 48 356 Electronic Travel Authority (Business Entrant-Short Stay) (subclass 977) visa applications lodged in the September 2011 quarter. This is a 7.9% increase in lodgements when compared to the same quarter in 2010 (44 827).

### 2 Visas granted

Visitor visa grants decreased by 4.3% in the September 2011 quarter (854 279) compared with the same period in 2010 (892 962). This can be partially attributed to a 11.6% decrease in subclass 976 grants (517 956 to 457 712) compared to the same quarter in 2010.

However, the decrease has been softened by the 9.9% increase (172 196 to 189 200) in subclass 676 visa grants and the 13.8% increase (51 563 to 58 703) in subclass 456 grants compared to the same quarter in 2010.

#### 3 Grant rates

The grant rate for Visitor visas (including Electronic Travel Authorities (ETAs)) for the September 2011 quarter remained relatively stable at 97.3% compared with the 97.7% grant rate for the same period in 2009-10.

The grant rate for subclass 679 visas decreased from 56.8% in the September 2010 quarter to 49.5% in the September 2011 quarter. This can be attributed to an increased scrutiny of applicants' claims and findings of non-genuineness.

### 4 Auto grant rates for eLodged Applications

The auto grant rates for eLodged Tourist (subclass 676) and eVisitor (subclass 651) visas for the September 2011 quarter were 60.6% and 87.4% respectively. These figures are consistent with the September 2010 quarter.

### 5 Processing times

During the September 2011 quarter, 75% of offshore subclass 456 applications were processed within five days and 50% within two days. Service standards aim for 75% of subclass 456 applications to be processed with one day for low risk applicants and one month for high-risk applicants.

During the September 2011 quarter, 75% of offshore subclass 676 applications were processed within nine days, 50% within five days and 25% within two days. Furthermore, 75% of onshore subclass 676 applications were processed within 13 days and 50% within one day. This is largely consistent with the previous four quarters.

Service standards aim for 75% of offshore subclass 676 applications to be processed with one day for low risk applicants and one month for high-risk applicants. For onshore 676 applications, the standard is one day and one week respectively.

During the September 2011 quarter, 75% of subclass 679 applications were processed within 57 days, 50% within 40 days and 25% within 26 days. This is largely consistent with the previous quarter. Service standards aim for 75% of subclass 679 visa application to be processed within 45 days.

#### 6 Applications on hand

On 30 September 2011 there were 74 341 Visitor visa applications on hand. This is higher than the 64 522 on hand on the same date in 2010.

To ensure that onshore applicants do not become unlawful because their existing visas expire before a new visa is granted, bridging visas are granted until a decision on their application is made.

#### 7 Visa holders In Australia

On 30 September 2011 there were 172 501 Visitor visa holders in Australia. Subclass 676 visa holders made up the largest cohort with 77 912 visa holders in Australia, followed by subclass 976 visa holders (60 240).

#### 8 Approved Destination Status (ADS)

There were 26 389 subclass 676 visas granted under the ADS scheme in the September 2011 quarter. This is the highest number of visas granted under the scheme for this quarter in the last four years. ADS visa holders made up 39% of all Chinese tourists to Australia in the September 2011 quarter, a decrease on the previous quarter. The Chinese New Year peak from December 2011 to February 2012 is expected to be the largest on record.

#### 9 Arrivals data

There were 62 686 arrivals on subclass 456 visas in the September 2011 quarter. This was slightly higher than the same period in 2010 (58 327 arrivals) and significantly higher than the same period in 2009 (47 808 arrivals).


There were 82 751 arrivals on subclass 651 visas in the September 2011 quarter. This is lower than the same period in 2010 (87 736 arrivals). This can be primarily attributed to a decrease in citizens of the United Kingdom applying for subclass 651 visas.

There were 202 487 arrivals on subclass 676 visas in the September 2011 quarter. This is the highest number of arrivals in this quarter in five years. This can be primarily attributed to the increase in inbound tourism by Chinese citizens.


There were 432 310 arrivals on subclass 976 visas in the September 2011 quarter. This is a decrease compared to the same quarters in 2011 (489 015) and 2009 (450 700).

There were 59 052 arrivals on subclass 977 visas in the September 2011 quarter. This is a small increase compared to the same quarter in 2010 (54 818). This can be partly attributed to an increase in subclass 977 visa grants to citizens of the United States of America (up 9.6%) and the United Kingdom (up 14%).


1.01 Number of Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




1.02 Number of Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




1.03 Number of Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year




1.04 Number of tourism Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




1.05 Number of business Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




1.06 Number of business Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year

1.08 Number of subclass 456 Business (Short Stay) visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous four financial years



1.09 Total number of subclass 651 eVisitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous three financial years




1.10 Number of subclass 651 eVisitor (business stream) visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous three financial years

# 1.12 Total number of subclass 676 Tourist visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous four financial years







1.15 Number of subclass 679 Sponsored Family Visitor visa applications lodged in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous four financial years










2.01 Number of Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by month comparison with previous four financial years




2.02 Number of Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




2.03 Number of Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year




2.04 Number of business Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




2.05 Number of tourism Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by visa subclass - comparison with same period in previous year




2.06 Number of business Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by citizenship country - comparison with same period in previous year

2.11 Number of subclass 651 eVisitor (tourism stream) visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous two financial years









# 2.15 Number of subclass 679 Sponsored Family Visitor visa applications granted in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous four financial years








7.01 Number of Visitor visa holders in Australia at the end of each month in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 by month - comparison with previous four financial years








9.01 Number of arrivals for subclass 456 Business (Short Stay) in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous four financial years




# 9.02 Number of arrivals for subclass 651 eVisitor in 2011-12 to 30 September 2011 - comparison with previous three financial years
