Notes on statistical tables presented by citizenship country

A result of 'na' indicates that the country did not have a Working Holiday Maker arrangement with Australia during the specified period. This may be because the arrangement had not yet commenced or the arrangement is no longer in place. Refer to the table 'Australia's Working Holiday Maker arrangements' in the 'Background to the Working Holiday Maker visa program' section.

A citizenship country of 'Not Specified' can result from eligible dual nationality applicants where the non-eligible nationality has been recorded for the WHM application.

Note 1: Data in years prior to 2017-18 was revised on 1 October 2019, due to better source data becoming available. This may result in minor discrepancies with previously published statistics.

Definition of terms

Citizenship country:	The country of citizenship of the visa applicant or visa holder. Where a visa applicant or visa holder has more than one citizenship country, either the citizenship of the travel document or the citizenship nominated by the visa applicant is used.
Granted:	Unless otherwise specified, the number of visas granted includes all visa grants.
Snapshot date:	The snapshot date is a point in time at which a count is undertaken. In this report, the number of visa holders in Australia at a point in time is used.
Visa applicant:	Used to refer to clients applying for a visa.
Working Holiday Maker:	Refers collectively to both the Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa and the Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa.

Background to the Working Holiday Maker visa program

The purpose of the Working Holiday Maker (WHM) visa program is to foster people-to-people links between Australia and partner countries, with particular emphasis on young adults. It has been in existence since 1975. Today, the WHM visa program includes two subclasses: the Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa and the Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa. Partner countries initially comprised a relatively small number of Commonwealth countries. The program now has 48 partner countries and regions from across the world.

Australia has an overarching bilateral arrangement, usually in the form of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), with each partner country or region. Of the 48 partner countries or regions, 19 are Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa arrangements, and 29 are Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa arrangements. The key difference between the two visas is that Work and Holiday visa arrangements generally have caps on the number of first visas granted in each program year and additional eligibility requirements.

WHM arrangements are largely reciprocal, providing Australians with similar opportunities overseas. In considering whether to add new WHM partner countries, the Australian Government considers a range of factors, including the ability of the prospective partner to offer reciprocity to Australians, and the strength of any people-to-people links.

Eligibility requirements

WHM (both Working Holiday and Work and Holiday) visa applicants must:

- be aged 18-30 (inclusive) at time of application. For Canada, France, Denmark, Ireland, and Italy the age is 18 to 35 (inclusive).
- hold a passport from an eligible partner country or region. A list of eligible countries and regions is provided in the 'Australia's Working Holiday Maker Visa Arrangements' section of this report
- not be accompanied by dependent children during their stay in Australia
- meet financial, health and character requirements.

Work and Holiday visa applicants must meet additional requirements, which vary between eligible countries, based on the agreements set out in the MOU for partner countries.

Working while in Australia

All WHMs may work for the full duration of their 12 month stay in Australia, but generally cannot remain with any one employer for longer than six months (by operation of mandatory visa condition 8547).

A visa holder may work for the same employer for a combined total of more than six months, provided the work is undertaken in a different location and work in any one location does not exceed six months. Studying while in Australia

All WHMs are entitled to study for a period of up to four months during their 12-month stay in Australia.

Second and third Working Holiday visas

First-time Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa holders who complete three months of 'specified subclass 417 work' during their stay acquire eligibility to apply for a second Working Holiday visa. Second Working Holiday visa holders who complete six months of 'specified subclass 417 work' during their stay acquire eligibility to apply for a third Working Holiday visa.

Specified subclass 417 work includes work in the agriculture, mining, construction, and tourism and hospitality industries, as well as bushfire and flood recovery work, and critical COVID-19 work in the healthcare and medical sectors.

Second and third Work and Holiday visas

First-time Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa holders who complete three months of 'specified subclass 462 work' during their stay acquire eligibility to apply for a second Work and Holiday visa. Second Work and Holiday visa holders who complete six months of 'specified subclass 462 work' during their stay acquire eligibility to apply for a third Work and Holiday visa.

Specified subclass 462 work includes work in the agriculture, construction and tourism and hospitality industries, bushfire and flood recovery work and critical COVID-19 work in the healthcare and medical sectors.

Recent developments in the Working Holiday Maker (WHM) visa program

- From 14 November 2020, former WHMs who were granted a COVID-19 Pandemic event visa to continue undertaking critical COVID-19 work in the healthcare and medical sectors could count this work as specified work towards eligibility for a second or third WHM visa. These arrangements recognise the contribution of WHMs doing critical COVID-19 work in the healthcare and medical sectors and ensured they could still access subsequent WHM visa options.
- From 22 June 2021, work undertaken in the tourism and hospitality sectors in northern, remote or very remote Australia could also be counted as specified work towards eligibility for a second or third WHM visa. This option was available for WHM applications lodged from 5 March 2022.
- From 19 January 2022 to 30 June 2023, WHMs working in any sector anywhere in Australia were allowed to work for the same employer or organisation for longer than six months without requesting permission from the department.
- On 1 July 2022, the Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa arrangements with both Brazil and Mongolia commenced with 500 and 100 annual visa places available respectively.
- In the context of the Australia-India Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement (AI-ECTA) signed on 2 April 2022, Australia has agreed to extend access to the Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa to up to 1,000 Indian citizens each year. These arrangements are expected to be implemented by December 2024.
- Australia and the UK have agreed to put in place new arrangements under the Working Holiday Maker (WHM) program and Youth Mobility Scheme. This follows the entry into force of the Australia-United Kingdom Free Trade Agreement (Australia-UK FTA) on 31 May 2023. Under the new arrangements, UK passport holders:
 - can apply for a Working Holiday visa between the ages of 18 and 35 years inclusive from 1 July 2023
 - will be granted up to three Working Holiday visas without having to meet any specified work requirements from 1 July 2024.Other partner country arrangements under the WHM program are established through bilateral negotiations. These will not be affected by the Australia and UK FTA.
- PNG will become the newest partner country to join the Working Holiday Maker (WHM) Program from 1 July 2023. This follows signing of an MOU and ongoing negotiations since 12 October 2011. The arrangement allows up to 100 PNG nationals to travel to Australia on a Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa and for up to 100 Australians to undertake a 12-month working holiday in Papua New Guinea.

Executive Summary

Key Points

This executive summary covers the WHM program from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023 (the 2022-23 program year). A general downturn in international travel due to the COVID-19 outbreak and strict border measures in place to protect the health of the Australian community significantly impacted the WHM program during the 2020-21 program year. There was an increase in lodgements and grants in 2021-22 which can be attributed to the recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic. The WHM program appears to have responded strongly since full re-opening of the borders, returning to pre-pandemic levels during the 2022-23 program year.

Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic years, a longer-term decline in demand for WHM visas had been observed over several years, possibly influenced by changing currency exchange rates and economic and labour market conditions in partner countries and Australia. It is unclear at this time if this previously observed downwards trajectory in WHM demand will continue in the post-pandemic years.

- As at 30 June 2023, a total of 137,391 WHM visa holders were in Australia, up from 40,912 at 30 June 2022.
- A total of 224,431 Working Holiday Maker (WHM) (subclass 417 and subclass 462) visas were granted in 2022-23, compared with 97,359 visa grants in 2021-22 - including:
 - 141,135 first, 14,987 second and 3,749 third Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa grants
 - 34,464 first, 5,938 second and 1,747 third Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visas grants
- The United Kingdom, France, Republic of Ireland and Taiwan were the top four citizenship countries of Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa grants in 2022-23. This is consistent with the previous 2021-22 program year. Cumulatively these citizenship countries accounted for 57.3 percent of grants.
- Indonesia, China, Argentina and the United States of America were the top four citizenship countries for Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa grants. Cumulatively accounting for 51.9 percent of grants in 2022-23.

1 Applications lodged for WHM program

In 2022-23, 221,696 visa applications were lodged for total WHM program, 131.2 per cent increase compared to 95,901 in 2021-22.

Working Holiday (subclass 417) first visa applications increased to 142,851, compared with 56,601 in 2021-22 and second visa applications increased to 14,631, up from 2,288.

Work and Holiday (subclass 462), first visa applications increased to 34,566, from 11,328 in 2021-22 and second visa applications increased to 5,928, from 558.

2 Visas granted

Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa program

A total of 178,306 visa applications were granted in 2022-23 compared to 79,896 in 2021-22.

First Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa program

A total of 141,135 first Working Holiday visas were granted in 2022-23, compared to 61,546 in 2021-22.

Top five countries for first Working Holiday visa grants were:

Second Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa program

A total of 14,987 second Working Holiday visas were granted in 2022-23, compared to 2,690 in 2021-22.

The top five countries for second Working Holiday visa grants were:

- Taiwan (2,870)
- United Kingdom (2,781)
- Ireland (2,103)
- South Korea (1,554)
- France (1,461)

In 2022-23, 54 per cent of those granted a second Working Holiday visa nominated agriculture as the industry in which they had undertaken "specified work" in order to acquire eligibility. A further 10.4 per cent nominated construction, 3.3 per cent mining.

Third Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa program

A total of 3,749 third Working Holiday visas were granted in 2022-23.

The top five countries or regions for third Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa grants were:

- United Kingdom (739)
- Taiwan (712)
- France (557)
- Ireland (393)
- Italy (316)

In 2022-23, 59.9 per cent of those granted a third Working Holiday visa nominated agriculture as the industry in which they had undertaken “specified work” in order to acquire eligibility. A further 15.7 per cent nominated construction, and 8.4 per cent mining.

Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa program

A total of 46,125 visa applications were granted in 2022-23, compared to 17,463 in 2021-22.

First Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa program

A total of 34,464 first Work and Holiday visas were granted in 2022-23, compared to 11,598 in 2021-22.

The top five countries for first Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa grants were:

- Indonesia (5,385)
- United States of America (4,367)
- China (4,091)
- Argentina (3,737)
- Chile (3,176)

Second Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa program

A total of 5,938 second Work and Holiday visas were granted in 2022-23, compared to 711 in 2021-22.

The top five countries for second Work and Holiday visa grants were:

- Indonesia (1,712)
- Vietnam (1,540)
- Thailand (527)
- Argentina (521)
- China (437)

In 2022-23, 54.9 per cent of those granted a second Work and Holiday visa nominated agriculture as the industry in which they had undertaken ‘specified work’ in order to acquire eligibility. A further 34.2 per cent nominated hospitality.

Third Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa program

A total of 1,747 third Work and Holiday visas were granted in 2022-23.

The top five countries for third Work and Holiday visa grants were:

- Indonesia (410)
- Vietnam (333)
- China (272)
- Argentina (208)
- Chile (80144)

In 2022-23, 51.2 per cent of those granted a third Work and Holiday visa nominated agriculture as the industry in which they had undertaken “specified work” in order to acquire eligibility. A further 38.6 per cent nominated hospitality and 5.1 per cent construction.

3 Grant rates

The grant rate for first Working Holiday visas in the six month period ending 30 June 23 was 99.5 per cent.

The grant rate for second Working Holiday visas was 97.9 per cent. The grant rate for third Working Holiday visas was 88.2 per cent.

The grant rate for first Work and Holiday visas was 97.2 per cent. The grant rate for second Work and Holiday visas was 99.1 per cent. The grant rate for third Work and Holiday visas was 96.8 per cent.

The generally high grant rates for WHM visas are indicative of the low risk nature of this caseload. The large proportion of online applications for this caseload also contributes to the high grant rate. A number of automated eligibility checks occur during online applications, alerting clients early in the process if they do not meet visa requirements.

4 Working Holiday Makers in Australia

Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa holders

As at 30 June 2023, there were 110,207 first, second and third Working Holiday visa holders in Australia. This is a 236.8 per cent increase compared to 32,719 on 30 June 2022.


Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa holders

As at 30 June 2023, there were 27,184 first, second and third Work and Holiday visa holders in Australia. This is a 231.8 per cent increase compared to 8,193 on 30 June 2022.



1.01 Total number of Working Holiday Maker visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




1.02 Total number of Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



1.03 Number of first Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




1.04 Number of second Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



1.05 Number of third Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years







1.08 Total number of Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




1.09 Number of first Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



1.10 Number of second Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




1.11 Number of third Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications lodged in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years































2.01 Total number of Working Holiday Maker visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




2.02 Total number of Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



2.03 Number of first Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




2.04 Number of second Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



2.05 Number of third Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years







2.08 Total number of Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




2.09 Number of first Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



2.10 Number of second Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years




2.11 Number of third Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by month - comparison with previous four financial years





















2.39 Second Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by employer industry




2.40 Third Working Holiday (subclass 417) visa applications granted in 2022-23 to 30 June 2023 by employer industry






