



Sea Passenger Terminal Security Guidance

The Department has released guidance to improve security at sea passenger terminals in response to the growth in the cruise ship sector and the current security environment. This Guidance will encourage industry to make security a key consideration in planning and designing a sea passenger terminal and its operations.

The Guidance includes information on the security measures available, practical case studies and resources to assist in determining which security measures are the most appropriate.
